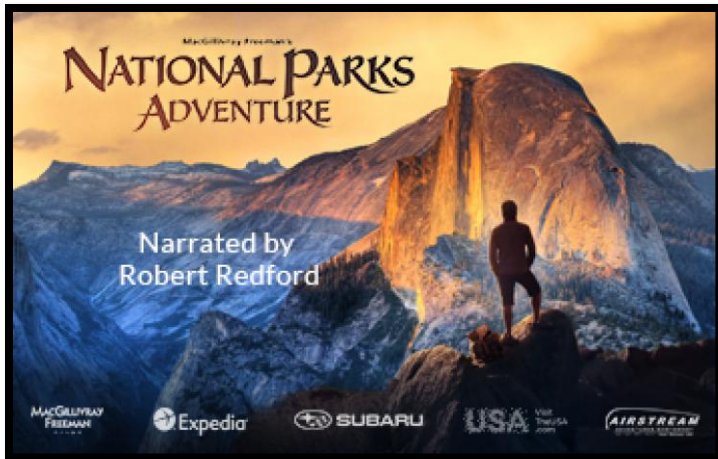


# OMSI AND RAILROAD MUSEUM
