The UP North Loop: 2,600 Miles Through the Inland Northwest



In May 2018, Ras and Kathy Vaughan, aka Team UltraPedestrian, set out hiking south from Hammett, Idaho. 174 days and 2,600 miles later they returned to their starting point to complete the first ever “UP North Loop.” Their route linked parts of the Idaho Centennial Trail, Oregon Desert Trail, Pacific Crest Trail, and Pacific Northwest Trail. In this talk Ras and Kathy share the origins of and inspiration for the UP North Loop; its unique physical, mental, and logistical challenges; the thrill of confronting six months of doubts and questions, and the beautiful brutality of seeing your plans crumble before your eyes.
