EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS CLASS

ASSESSING AN INJURED OR ILL PERSON



The class will cover emergencies in the outdoors, with special emphasis on how to assess a person who is injured or ill. A hands-on approach will be used to teach assessment skills along with first aid that can be given to stabilize a person suffering from an injury or illness. The session will not lead to a certification of any kind, but it is a chance to increase your outdoor emergency knowledge and skills. Lyndell Wilken, the Wilderness First Aid instructor at Lane Community College, will be the presenter. The cost is \$5.00 (\$10 for nonmembers) to be paid the day of the class at the Lodge.
