

Whitey Lueck will be showing slides from his master's work in forest ecology at Oregon State University. He lived on Bachelor Butte in the Deschutes National Forest and studied the whitebark pine tree at timberline on the volcanic peak (its highest elevation). His interesting and amusing observations include the critical role and close relationship of the Clark's Nutcracker with the whitebark pine.
